B. TACONY ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL CEO

- a. Mr. Thomas Scheid—Chief Executive Officer of Tacony Academy Charter School
 - i. Reviewed and discussed with the Board the March 2022 CEO report, previously disseminated to the Board;
 - ii. Reviewed and discussed the enrollment data;
 - iii. Updated the Board on disciplinary matters, noting that the school is striving to ensure a certain threshold of students are not receiving out-of-school suspensions;
 - iv. Updated the Board with recent school events;
 - v. Provided staff recognition for:
 - Mr. Todd Parker, Direct or Student Data and Operations, for being a nominee for the Annual Outstanding PDE PIMS Administrator; and
 - 2. Mr. Paul Reiser, Athletic Directors and Climate Community Coordinator, who was recognized as PSADA Region 1 Athletic Director.
 - vi. Shared with the Board various athletic recognitions;
 - vii. Updated the Board on DEI matters, including an upcoming symposium with Dr. Whitaker and Dr. Cornel West; and

viii. Upon questioning by the Board, he informed the Board that he would look into why there were recent departures of SPED families.

C. AMERICAN PARADIGM SCHOOLS

- a. Ms. Fanty Marc, Director of Instruction Coaching
 - i. Shared with the Board what being an instructional coaching is like, noting that coaches offer insight to teachers from a 3rd perspective which might be otherwise be missed by the teacher.
 - ii. Indicated that coaches provide job-embedded training and that personalized support is important;
 - iii. Shared various activities coaches do, including classroom visits, coaching meetings, principal meetings, and curating teacher materials.
 - iv. Answered Board question about how schools/teachers are chosen for coaching by noting that, at the end of each coaching rotation, APS meets with school leadership teams to learn where support is needed.
- b. Ms. Ashley Fisher, Academic Coach
 - i. Informed the Board that long term growth does not happen if there is no dialogue, choice, and equity.
 - ii. Expressed that teacher training being specific is important;
 - iii. Shared with the Board the Teacher Action Goals, noting the need to recognize (a) Desired Outcome, (b) Actual Outcome, (c) and Feedback;
 - iv. *Shared positive testimonials of teachers who were coached last* year, and noted that coaching is a partnership not a punishment.

D. BUSINESS CONTROLLER

- a. Mr. Peter Costa—Santilil & Thomson, LLC
 - i. Informed the Board of S&T's collaboration with TACS concerning the hudget:
 - ii. Informed the Board that there will likely be an adjustment in April due to potential issue with SDP's internal system that resulted in certain students not being credited for subsidy purposes;
 - iii. Informed the Board that cash was at \$5.1M, representing 101 days;
 - iv. Informed the Board that there were minor negative variances;
 - v. Expressed that the school was financially strong;
 - vi. Informed the Board that Philadelphia new COVID-19 ordinance for time-off will likely not impact the budget.
